

Mystery 2006-07

Have a stash overflowing your sewing room? Why not join in our mystery and begin to put a dent in your stash! It will be great fun! The quilt size is 67" x 79 ¾". Let's get started!

You will need an assortment of twenty ¼ yd. fabrics. I would suggest using tone-on-tone fabrics, batiks, etc. I would try to avoid large scale prints.

From each of the ¼ yd. fabrics cut:

- (2) 7 ¼" squares
- (2) 4 ¼" squares
- (1) 3 ½" squares
- (4) 2" squares

Background Fabrics: Choose two fabrics similar in tone and color.

Fabric A: 1 yd. Cut the following:

- (2) strips: 4 ¼" x WOF (width of fabric). Subcut into 20 squares.
- (4) strips: 3 ½" x WOF. Subcut these into (80) 2' x 3 ½" rectangles.
- (4) strips: 2" X WOF. Subcut these strips into (80) 2" squares.

Fabric B: 3/8 yd. Cut the following:

- (2) strips 4 ¼" x WOF. Subcut (20) 4 ¼" squares.
